Expanding our use of technology and providing customers with options that don't require a visit to the office to access service is among our top priorities.

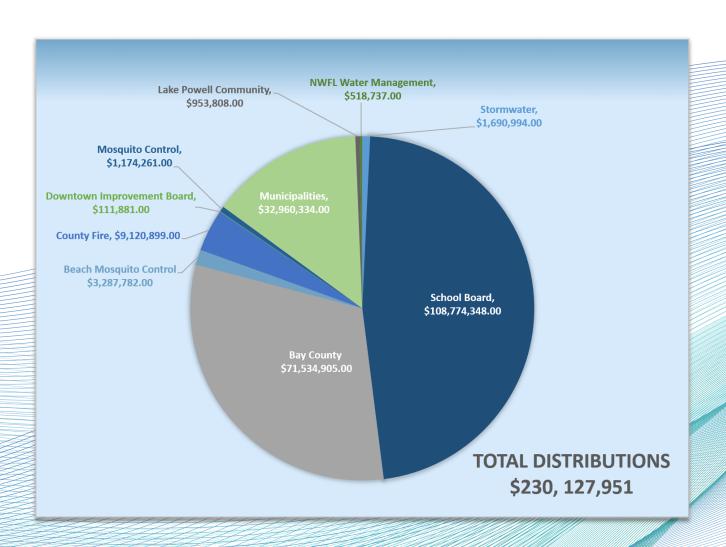
We're excited about Bay County's future. Please take a look at some of the steps we've taken over this last year to get ready for what is on the horizon.

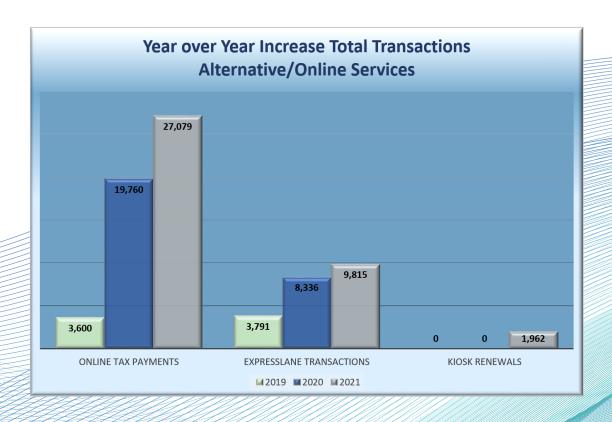

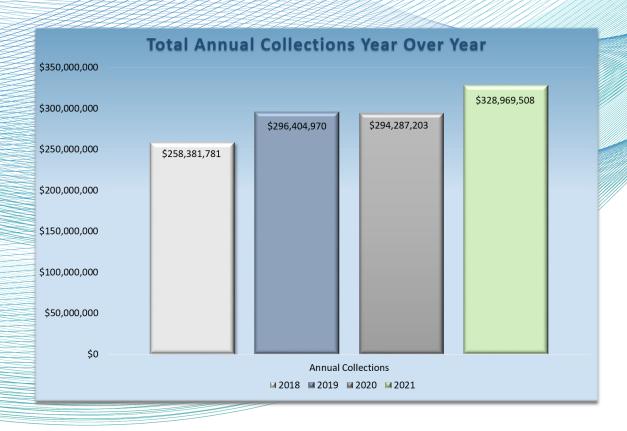
